Dear Parent / Guardian,

I hope you had some time to relax over the bank holiday. I would like to update you with some important messages.

#### RE-OPENING:

There has been a lot of speculation in the press and on social media over the past week. I kindly draw your attention to these messages from Welsh Government on the matter: <https://gov.wales/situation-schools-will-not-change-june-1st-education-minister-says>. The message is consistent from the Minister for Education and Skills for Wales, in relation to the 5 key principles for re-opening schools - see here: <https://gov.wales/education-minister-sets-out-five-key-principles-schools-return>. Naturally, we will keep you informed of any developments as soon as any further information can be shared.

#### WELLBEING:

With the Whitsun half-term holiday approaching, we feel strongly that it is a good opportunity for pupils to have a break from schoolwork during this period. Work will not be set for pupils at all during the week and pupils are NOT expected to spend time on schoolwork during the half-term break. It would be beneficial for all our pupils' wellbeing if they spent quality time with family, contacted friends and family on-line and ensured they were exercising daily during this break.

As is our current practice, we will continue to contact our pupils who require support during the half term holiday. However, if you feel you would like to discuss any concerns about your child's welfare, please get in touch. #### DISTANCE LEARNING:

Naturally, we will continue to set tasks, in accordance with the timetable over the two weeks leading up to half-term. Also, please see our website for resources to support pupils and parents. If you have any concerns - please contact us.

#### After the Whitsun half-term:

The nature of distance learning will continue as at present for **years 7, 8, 10 and 12** after half-term.

However, as **year 9** pupils have completed their GCSE options, it is our intention to begin our usual interim timetable with year 9 pupils, enabling learners to begin studying their GCSE courses for the last half-term (there will be no new timetable - we will continue to work in accordance with the current assigned timetable). Our aim here is to motivate year 9 pupils to continue to engage with their distance learning. However, we are very aware of the concerns of learning new information and subject knowledge without the direct support of their teachers, particularly in some subjects that will be completely new to our pupils.

As a result, the teachers will provide a video that will introduce the subject and then tasks to develop their background knowledge through reading, research and some interesting opportunities to gather knowledge in relation to their new courses. There will be on-going help and support with tasks to test understanding through digital quizzes and question and answer sessions on the Teams platform (as and when they are required). If you have any concerns, please encourage your child to contact their teachers for further help and support.

**Year 11** pupils will be provided with work that 'prepares pupils for 6th Form courses' and we expect all pupils who wish to return to the 6th Form to engage with these tasks. These tasks will be set on SMHW for all year 11 pupils as their choices for the 6<sup>th</sup> Form will not be confirmed until after they receive their results in August. However, teachers are aware of the provisional choices our year 11 made in February in order to create our options columns.

**Year 13** pupils are expected to prepare for their university courses through specific reading and research. Again, please encourage pupils to contact subject teachers for guidance and support here.



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**WELSHNESS:** please encourage your child to check the weekly Welshness challenges Miss Clarke has set for them on SMHW. This is a great opportunity for you to learn more Welsh – why not have go at it with your children! #### COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS:

We will continue to update our parents via text messages with a link to the website to share important updates - please check our website regularly for any developments. Please follow the school on twitter: @bryntawe as there is also a wealth of information shared here, as well as numerous accounts run by different departments and year groups. The work of the school continues and we are open daily, so please contact us at school or via the e-mail address below to discuss any issues. See the information below:

**Weekly and weekend emergency childcare:** contact me directly on [DaviesS456@hwbcymru.net](mailto:DaviesS456@hwbcymru.net) or via the school e-mail address to discuss any further requirements.

**Free School Meals:** we are delivering weekly bags to around 140 school pupils and their families every Monday. We have been able to discuss provision with nearly all of our families about these arrangements, but please contact us at school if your child is eligible and you would like to receive a weekly delivery. There are ongoing discussions to offer BACS payment (to parents of eligible pupils) as an alternative to the weekly delivery, though this remains unconfirmed. We will require a parent's current email address to be able to implement payments, should it become a possible option. Please send your e-mail address to [LeonardE18@hwbcymru.net](mailto:LeonardE18@hwbcymru.net) and [BowenJ129@hwbcymru.net](mailto:BowenJ129@hwbcymru.net) if your child is eligible for free school meals.

**Laptops:** We have 'loaned' approximately 90 laptops to our pupils to support with distance learning. If they have received a device, can you please ensure that your child makes the best possible use of the equipment, ensuring they are returned in the same condition in which they were received from the school. We track and monitor the work pupils submit to their teachers and will contact pupils who do not submit work in order to collect their laptops as the loaning of devices is in high demand.

**Penlan food bank:** School staff volunteer weekly to support the Penlan food bank. Contact us for more details in relation to this facility.

**Visors:** We continue to provide visors for healthcare workers in our community, with over 1000 now distributed.
