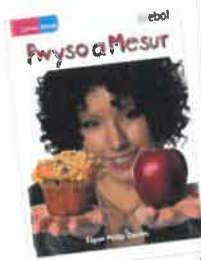

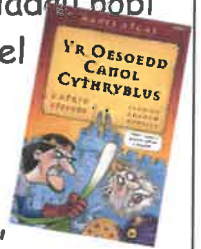

# English: How can you help?

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Here are 5 helpful hints on how you can support your son/daughter with their work in English.

## 1. Spelling and Vocabulary



Every pupil has a personalised spelling and vocabulary book in the back of the English book. Can you help ensure that this is update on a regular basis? You could set some spelling tests on the lists provided or more challenging vocabulary.



## 2. Read, read, read...



Encouraging your child to read every day is vital in developing literacy skills and confidence. Your child should also have a reading book in their school bag every day! The department have provided reading lists for all year groups. All Swansea libraries are free to join, and more information can be obtained via <http://www.swansea.gov.uk/libraries>



## 3. Homework

The completion of homework is crucial in ensuring your child is fully up-to-date with tasks in English. Homework can include research, or reading and writing tasks based on what is being studied during this term (you can discover this by looking in your child's English book). Fortnightly quizzes will be set on SMHW (Show My Homework) and learners will also be expected to complete activities based on their Knowledge Organisers.

Why not discuss homework tasks together or encourage your child to complete an 'extra' homework from the 'English Express' menu (located in the front of the English book)?



## 4. Digital Learning

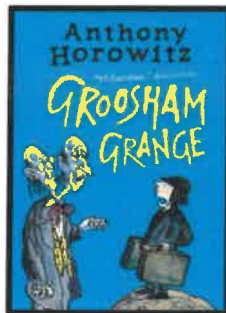

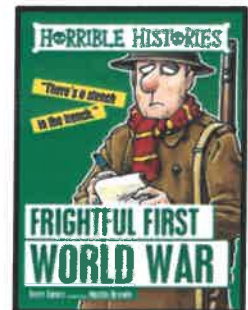

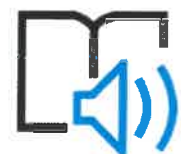

## How can you help?

**Pupils should practise their spelling skills during short sessions.**

**Use a spelling board.**

- **Read the spelling list with your child, check if they understand the meaning of each word.**
- **Ask your child if there are any words in the list which they are already able to spell.**
- **Check if they can spell them correctly.**
- **Look for any words that cause your child problems and ask them to study these words individually.**
- **Can your child see each individual letter in the correct order?**
- **Ask your child to close their eyes and try to remember the letters in the correct order.**
- **Ask your child to open their eyes and spell the word from memory.**
- **If they have difficulties, ask he/she to look at the word again and try to remember the difficult part.**
- **Once he/she writes the word correctly, ask them to cover the word and write it once again.**
- **Praise your child.**
- **After a while, check if your child can remember how to spell the words which caused them difficulties.**

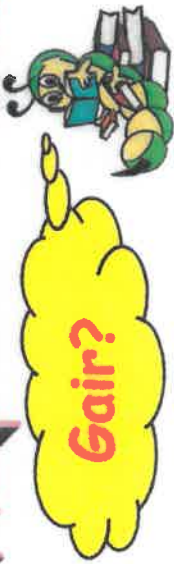

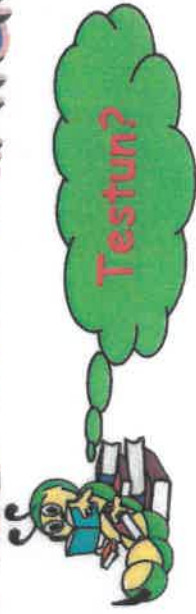
