Over recent years, the school has set up a system whereby pupils earn the privilege of attending the prom by collecting prom points. Traditionally, earning these prom points has been based on the pupils' records for behaviour, daily effort as well as their attendance. This year however, the prom points system will be adjusted so that difficulties caused by the pandemic will be taken into consideration. Pupils will need 140 Prom points in order to purchase a Prom ticket.

From Monday the 14th of March 2022, pupils have had the chance to collect the following prom points;

- 1 point – morning registration mark and punctuality to lessons 1 to 4
- 1 point – afternoon registration mark and punctuality to lessons 5 and 6
- 1 point – wearing the correct school uniform / following the jewellery policy

The School will be responsible for collating these points.

Pupils are responsible for collecting the following points;

- 1 point – completing a past paper
- 1 point – attending a revision session (lunch time or after School)
- 1 point – an exceptional piece of work / effort / attitude.

Any negative SIM point collected from Monday the 14th of March will deduct prom points from the pupils.

The school is very aware that attendance of the school prom may place a financial burden on parents. Please note that should Covid-19 regulations change, it may yet be not possible for this year's prom to proceed. The school cannot accept responsibility for any prom expenditure should the event be cancelled. Therefore, it is recommended that spending on the event is minimised until arrangements are finalised.
