National Literacy and Numeracy Personalised Assessments (online)

We write to inform you that year 8 learners will complete the personalised assessments for literacy and numeracy (online) during next week (9th to 14th May). The personalised assessments focus on literacy and numeracy proficiencies and learners will complete 4 online assessments covering the following areas:

- English reading assessment
- Numeracy (Procedural and reasoning assessments)
- Welsh reading assessment

Learners will also be given time to practise the question types as part of their lessons during this week.

We would like to remind learners and parents that these assessments are a national performance indicator, and learners should give of their best during these sessions.


