

TUESDAY'S TRIPS(19/7/22) & HOT WEATHER

As I'm sure you're aware it is forecast to be very hot at the beginning of next week. Please read the following information/advice carefully.

At school – pupils are advised to bring plenty of drink, water re-fill stations are available and be sensible with regards to time spent in the sun. Hats(whilst outdoors) & sun cream are advised and pupils can wear their school PE shorts or uniform shorts during this hot weather. Lycra/tight shorts are not permitted.

End of year trips - If your child is attending one of the end of year trips – please ensure that they have plenty of drinks, a hat, sunscreen and appropriate clothing(covering their bodies to ensure they don't burn – no minimalistic beach wear/sports etc) for the activities. Some activities will be outdoors for most of the day, whilst others they will be able to shelter.

Please see some additional information for each venue/trip:

Yr7/8 - Heatherton – there is some shade available(Cafe, some queuing areas etc) but not much shade – pupils should be sensible and try to find shade as much as possible.

Yr8 – Paintballing – pupils are provided with protective overalls. It is advisable to wear light clothing underneath(eg shorts & t-shirt) and to bring spare clothes for afterwards. A packed lunch is required.

Yr7/8 - Bowling/Limitless – indoors for most of the day. Pupils have the option of a burger at Limitless and is included in the price – if pupils do not want the burger option – please bring a packed lunch.

Yr9 - Aquapark – there is very little/no shade during the day – pupils will need wet & dry clothes & a towel, changing facilities are available at the site. Wetsuits are included in the price but will probably be optional on the day as it may be too hot for wetsuits? Life vests are provided and are compulsory – see Home Page - Aqua Park Group for more information.

Yr 10 – Ice skating – This is indoors and in a cold environment – pupils will need long trousers. They can bring shorts and change if necessary as we are hoping to take them for a short walk/ice cream before skating. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch.



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Yr 9/10 – Cardiff shopping – pupils will need to be sensible regarding the weather and take advantage of the shade in the shopping centre & shops when possible. Staff will be at a given location each hour to meet any pupils if there are any problems, pupils will also be given a mobile phone number on the day so that they can contact staff if there are any problems. Pupils will be expected to stay with school friends at all times & pupils will have freedom to go within a given area of Cardiff.

I'm sure you understand and agree that taking over 400 pupils off site for the end of year trips is a big responsibility for the staff, and which we are eager to do in order to provide different and enjoyable experiences for pupils. We know that the majority of pupils will represent the school impeccably, but please could all parents remind their children of the need to be respectful and behave correctly whilst representing Ysgol Bryn Tawe.



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
