- 4. - 5. Changes to our Mobile Phone Policy: Overuse of mobile phones and the time pupils spend in front of screens remains a growing concern due to the potentially negative impact on pupils' learning and wellbeing. Mobile phones are distracting for many learners during the school day. It is vitally important that learners in school can fully focus on their learning during lessons and spend quality time socialising



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together in their free time. In light of this, and having consulted with our pupils, our parents' voice forum and school staff, we are going **to implement some important changes to our mobile phone policy at school**. There are many studies into the negative effects of screen time on young people's mental health, wellbeing and brain development and we feel it is our duty to take these important steps in an effort to support the wellbeing and learning of all pupils.

6. SMHW – 'SatchelOne'

The use of the 'SatchelOne' App by parents and pupils is vital – it includes details of your child's homework, praise points and important messages. This year we have added negative/behaviour points into the App, to further improve our communication with our parents. If you or your child do not have access to the App, please ask your child's personal tutor for the login details.

- 7. Uniform and dress code: I would like to remind you of our expectations for the appearance and dress code of our pupils, which is a source of pride for us at Bryn Tawe. We require the support of all parents to ensure your child meets these expectations and would like to specifically draw attention to jewellery pupils in years 7-11 are not permitted allowed to wear piercings in their nose. As previously communicated, second-hand uniform is available to collect from school please contact us via the methods below to make arrangements for collection.
- 8. Data collection: it is important we ensure that we have the most up-to-date information for all of our learners. We therefore ask all parents to complete <u>this data collection form</u> (if you have not already done so). This information is vital as it provides us with all the necessary details we require to support the learning and wellbeing of our pupils. In addition, we promote pupils' experiences and achievements by sharing their successes with photographs on our website, the school's social media platforms and occasionally with the local press. We ask all parents to provide or withdraw consent in relation to using photographs of learners.
- 9. **School equipment**: Once again, a reminder to ensure that your child has the necessary equipment for everyday school learning, particularly stationery and Mathematics equipment. Once again, should you have any concerns in providing such resources, please contact us so we can support all learners.
- 10. Absence policy: We strongly urge all parents/guardians not to book family holidays during term time as such absences can have a negative impact on learners' education.
