Dear Parent / Guardian,

I feel it is a good opportunity at the start of the school year to remind parents of the key health and safety arrangements when you drop off and collect your child from the school.

#### MORNING ARRIVAL ARRANGEMENTS:

- We ask parents/guardians and all site-users to adhere to the expected speed limit
  of no more than 10mph on the school site (including the main drive to the school
  off Heol Gwyrosydd) at all times.
- Safety barriers have been installed along the walking route to separate pedestrians from traffic on the main lane to the school. It is vitally important that pupils stay on the pavement at all times.
- Pupils, who walk along the main lane, will need to be careful when crossing both entrances to the leisure centre car parks.
- Staff will be on duty to support the safety of our pupils.

## **Bus:**

• Pupils travelling via school transport (buses or taxis) will be dropped off in the new bus bay and walk on a safe route (on the pavement) up to school.

### Walk:

Pupils who walk will follow the same procedure as usual when walking on a safe
path, on the pavement, up to school. (The back gate will also remain open for pupils
wishing to gain access from the upper side of Cadifor Road.)

# Car:

- Pupils receiving a lift to school will continue to be dropped at the kerbside outside the school canteen.
- There are specific spaces in the barriers outside the school canteen so that parents / guardians have space to drop off their child(ren) safely. This is the only safe designated area to drop-off on arrival at the site.
- Ensure that your child(ren) has enough space to safely open the car door in this area.
- We kindly ask parents not to delay for longer than necessary in order to drop-off their child(ren) safely and this will help ensure a safe flow of traffic.

## **END OF DAY DEPARTURE ARRANGEMENTS:**

- With up to 900 pupils leaving the site along the main lane to the school at the same time, we will have to prevent any movement by vehicles on-site during this period to ensure the safety of our pupils.
- We will close the vehicle barrier between 15:00 15:20. Vehicles will not be able to move between these times during term-time, including in the leisure centre car parks.

- We ask parents/guardians and all site-users to adhere to the expectation of not driving at more than 10mph on the school site at all times.
- We ask that all parents refrain from parking on the main drive to the school, before the barrier. Traffic movement (cars moving reversing and turning) in this area presents a higher risk to the safety of our pupils as many cross the drive as they walk home.
- Safety barriers have been installed along the walking route to separate pedestrians from traffic on the main lane to the school. It is vitally important that pupils stay on the pavement at all times.
- Pupils, who walk along the main lane, will need to be careful when crossing the two entrances to the leisure centre car parks.
- Staff will be on duty to support the safety of our pupils.

#### Bus:

- Pupils travelling on school transport (buses or taxis) will walk on a safe route (on the pavement) up to the bus bay.
- Although there is enough time to reach the bus bay within 10 minutes, it is vitally
  important that pupils don't delay and make every effort to reach the bus bay on
  time, as the school buses will still depart at 15:20.

#### Walk:

• Pupils who walk will follow the same procedure as usual when walking on a safe path, on the pavement, when leaving school. (The back gate will also remain open to pupils wishing to access the upper side of Cadifor Road.)

### Car:

- It will still be possible to collect your child(ren) for transport home by car.
- We ask that you use the herring-bone parking area to collect your child(ren) and not to use the leisure centre car parks.
- As noted above, no vehicle will be able to move on-site between 15:00 15:20.
- We kindly ask all parents / guardians to respect these health and safety measures for the benefit of all pupils at the school.
